Manufacturer position regard Proposition 65 "Safe Drinking Water and Toxic Enforcement Act"

Badestnost JSCo manufactures valves, hand pumps and spare parts for these assemblies. The products are targeted for industrial applications and they are sold to authorized distributors in the whole world, including North America.

Our products are a combination of parts with different materials - cast iron, steel, rubber, plastic and etc., like some of them may contain trace amounts of chemicals listed on the California Proposition 65 list that are known to cause cancer, reproductive health or birth defects. During normal use, maintenance, or repair, the probability or the potential for contact with these chemicals for end-user is extremely low. In many of cases there may be no actual exposure to the chemical. To meet the requirements of Proposition 65, we adding the "short form" label to the individual packaging (because is difficult to affix a warning directly on the product itself) for all products and spare parts, regardless of their materials of construction, ordered of our distributors for North America. The warnings do not mean that the products are unsafe!

The "short form" label looks like this:



Badestnost JSCo. does not offer direct internet sales in North America. If you resell our products, please ensure that the label for Proposition 65 warnings remain with the products and are passed on to your customers. This obligation is your responsibility. Please take special care when selling individual spare parts that were part of a multipack. For spare parts:

- we adding the "short form" label to the individual packaging if the spare part is only one or
- we adding the "short form" label to the multipack if the spare parts are more than one, with option for additional quantity individual labels who can use by resell.

The California Office of Environmental Health Hazard Assessment, (OEHHA) administers the Proposition 65 program and for more information you can visit their websites at https://www.p65warnings.ca.gov or https://oehha.ca.gov/proposition-65. You can also find there the list of chemicals which fall under Proposition 65 requirements and that list is subject of change.
